ABPA has an advisory board and a board of directors that guide how it works alongside the other stakeholders.


The membership structure of ABPA comprises

# Brazil's Poultry- and Pork-raising Industries and their Social Impacts



Brazil has a natural talent for producing food. The country's plentiful supply of cereals and its favorable climate are the drivers of productivity gains - even before any use of advanced technology. After significant investments and five decades of sectoral professional enhancement, Brazil's poultry-raising and pig-raising industries stand out for their competitive edge.

These highly developed segments generate 4.1 million direct and indirect jobs: their social effects are remarkable. Brazil's poultry and pork industries have adopted an "integrated" production model: over 100,000 families are engaged in a system of contract farmers that keeps men and women farmers on the land.

There are scores of small towns throughout the heart of the country, whose economies depend

directly and indirectly on slaughterhouses in the region. Several of these towns rank among the country's most highly-developed cities, in accordance with a survey conducted by Embrapa Suínos e Aves, (the government agricultural research company's poultry and pigs branch) based upon data from the Rio de Janeiro State Federation of Industries (FIRJAN).

The social benefits of poultry and pig-raising go far beyond the generation of employment and income. In urban areas, chicken meat and pork, and eggs, are essential for ensuring food security. These are three of the most commonly-consumed sources of protein in Brazil – chicken meat is, per capita, the most widely consumed. These industries play exactly the same role in more than 150 nations worldwide. There are no frontiers to food security for Brazil's poultry- and pig-raising industries.



# Sustainable Animal Protein

Brazil's animal protein exporting industry is noted for its sustainability.

The favorable climate, and investments in renewable energy sources, enable Brazil to produce chicken meat at levels of CO<sub>2</sub> emissions 45% below those of the United Kingdom, and 50% lower than France's chicken production segment, according to data published by DEFRA-UK.

Furthermore, virtually all of Brazil's poultry meat and pork production comes from areas outside the Amazon biome. Brazil's southern and south-eastern regions account for more than 80% of production of those proteins.

In this way, while internal factors help bring down CO<sub>2</sub> emissions, the companies are investing in countless initiatives designed to preserve and reuse resources, in order to boost productivity and reduce environmental impacts.

Brazil's environmental legislation is one of the

most-advanced and far-reaching in the world, mandating actions that aim to conserve the environment by directly involving the actors in the production chains.

The environmental legal framework as it has been put into place by the Brazilian Forestry Code and the Low-Carbon Agriculture Program requires such steps as the introduction of permanent preservation areas.

According to data published by Embrapa Territorial (2017), over 5,600,000 km<sup>2</sup>, in other words 66.3% of the territory, is made up of areas dedicated to protecting, preserving and conserving the country's native vegetation. On average, with 30.2% of its territory occupied by farms and holdings, rural Brazil uses only half (50.1%) of the surface area of its properties. Nearly one-quarter (25.6%) of the entire area of the country, according to the Rural Environmental Registry (Cadastro Ambiental Rural — CAR), is dedicated to the preservation of native vegetation on rural properties.

# Food Safety and Food Security

Permanent, sustainable access to wholesome food is one of the largest global challenges to the food security of populations. Brazil is one of the world's largest protein producers and exporters: its ability to supply safe, sustainable products has become one the country's fundamental commitments to ensuring the world market's continued access.

Brazil's privileged position is the result of the country's natural capacity for producing foods, as well as the sanitary status of its herds and flocks. It is one of the few poultry-producing countries worldwide never to have recorded an outbreak of Avian Influenza.

Nor has the country reported a single case of African Swine Fever (ASF) for over forty years. Both of these are notifiable diseases for the World Animal Health Organization (OIE) and would restrict and/or prevent access to a wide range of markets. So there is a permanent on-going effort to maintain biosecurity and animal welfare.

Good manufacturing practices have enabled Brazil's poultry and pork industries to move forwards in their commitments to the prudent use of antimicrobials. This is in line with regulatory processes laid down by the Ministry of Agriculture, Livestock, and Food Supply (MAPA), which follows the guidelines of the tripartite intergovernmental organizations WHO/FAO/OIE.

ABPA is a member of the ALLIANCE for the responsible use of antimicrobials, and has supported sectoral discussions and educational initiatives to encourage the responsible and rational use of antimicrobials. One of the ALLIANCE's mottoes has been to promote and disseminate throughout the several links in the production chain, practices that will help prevent animal diseases.



# Animal Welfare

Good production practices are principles that inform the output of companies associated with ABPA. Brazil's Official Veterinary Service performs the mandatory inspection of the companies' self-control programs. A range of tools are employed in order to monitor the welfare of the animals and oversee all the stages of production.

Companies are expected to comply with standards for the welfare of animals raised for slaughter and these range from the means of transport of live animals to the stunning methods used in humane slaughter.



# Sustainable Development Goals – SDGs

## United Nations (UN)

The United Nations' Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) were launched in 2015, in order to continue the work of the Millennium Development Goals (MDGs).

The multi-sectoral SDGs aim to address mankind's challenges by putting forward 17 objectives and 169 goals for such areas as hunger, sanitation, biodiversity, ethics, and human and social rights.

ABPA, as a member and partner of the International Poultry Council (IPC), has undertaken to focus on five of the 17 UN Sustainable Development Goals, and encourages its members to introduce measure that can help achieve these goals.

**Goal 2 - Zero Hunger:** To eradicate hunger, attain food security, improve nutrition, and promote sustainable agriculture; To share good practices and promote sustainable production.



**Goal 3 - Good Health and Well-being:** Ensuring healthy lives and promoting well-being for everyone at all ages; Promoting poultry meat as a healthy choice and sharing good handling and production practices.



**Goal 4 - Quality Education:** Promoting capacity-building so as to ensure sustainable quality and production - Supporting research and scientific projects, congresses and events.



**Goal 9 - Industry, Innovation, and Infrastructure:** Supporting innovative and sustainable industry. Focusing on the efficiency of resource use in order to make our footprint more sustainable and enhance the aspects of animal health and welfare. Focusing on improvements in infrastructure in order to minimize food wastage.



**Goal 13 - Climate Action (climate change):** To encourage all stakeholders in the value chain to introduce the most recent innovations and contribute towards the sustainability goals. Promoting and supporting holistic, low-emissions strategies; including the concepts of precision agriculture, throughout the chain.






## Destination of Brazilian Chicken Meat Production in 2019




## World Chicken Meat Market












## Share of Brazilian Exports by Region in 2019
















## Share of Brazilian Exports by Region













## Share of Brazilian Exports by Region in 2019







## Share of Brazilian Exports by Region in 2019





## Share of Brazilian Exports by Region in 2019





